



- As of February 2022 WB had 12 active projects
- With the total portfolio size of US\$3,36b
- Of which around **US\$1,56bn** (46%) was undisbursed
- Our current investment portfolio consists of 18 projects
- With the total portfolio size US\$6,64bn
- And around **US\$700 mln** includes procurement and is undisbursed
- By the end of the current Fiscal Year (June 30, 2024)
  we plan to approve at least 1 new project and series of additional financing. Share of it will include procurement

- Recovery and reconstruction estimates integrated green, resilient, and inclusive reconstruction measures and consider prevailing challenges with labor and material costs and "surge" pricing
- Transport makes up 22 percent of total needs (US\$92.1 billion), subject to assumptions about the configuration of Ukraine's transport networks during reconstruction
- Housing makes up 17 percent of total needs (US\$68.6 billion)
- Energy makes up 11 percent of total needs (US\$47 billion)
- Social protection and livelihoods equals 10 percent of the total needs (US\$41.8 billion), including social benefits and services, payments to IDPs and the newly impoverished
- Explosive hazards management (humanitarian demining) makes up 9 percent (US\$37.6 billion), due to massive urban, agricultural and forestry areas contaminated by land mines and explosive remnants of war
