



### Real GDP



Change from March 2019 to December of the previous year










Dynamics of metallurgical production and world prices for ferrous metals,

% to corresponding month of the previous year




The dynamics of industrial production in Ukraine as a whole and Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts, cumulatively,




# Agriculture, % to corresponding period of the previous year



## Dynamics of livestock production, % to corresponding period of the previous year




## Dynamics of production of main agricultural crops, % to the corresponding date of the previous year (as of month 1-st)







# Retail and real wages, *% to corresponding period of the previous year*



## Wage arrears, mln UAH (as of month 1-st)






## Consumer prices, %



%, Change from March to December of the previous year




Consumer prices for some groups of goods and services,  
%, Change from March to December of the previous year





mln USD






